SMBS NEED TO CONSIDER DR PLANNING FOR THE CLOUD



Despite increasing cloud adoption, small and medium-sized (SMB) firms are unprepared to recover quickly if there is a cloud or service outage caused by a physical or cyber threat.

82%

of decision-makers use cloud to extend, transition, or transform their business, but a third have not incorporated public cloud workloads into their IT disaster recovery (DR) planning.

EXISTING DR AND BC PLANS FOR THE CLOUD ARE INSUFFICIENT

Only 24% think their business continuity (BC) plan currently meets the needs of their business very well.



Only 22% are very confident their firm's DR plan will meet the needs of their business next year.



54% don't have a formal DR program in place at all.



PREVENT BUSINESS REPERCUSSIONS BY PLANNING FOR CLOUD DR AND BC

Firms recognize that failing to prepare a DR and BC plan for the cloud would result in a plethora of damages.

99% of SMB leaders are concerned that their DR and BC plans could fail.


